REPORT ON SCHOLARSHIP DISBURSEMENT OUTREACH FOR GIRL CHILD EDUCATION

As it is her annual routine, the Premordia Charity Foundation NGO carried out a scholarship disbursement outreach on 3rd January, 2025, in Tyoado Community, Gboko LGA in Benue State. This is to support underprivileged girls to have access to better education. Three schools were reached by the organization, benefiting 31 students with financial assistance and awareness on the importance of Girl-Child education.

Premordia Charity Foundation NGO is committed to empowering young girls through education. This outreach aimed to support girls from humble backgrounds by providing scholarships and sensitizing the community on the importance of female education. The program targeted students from three schools in Tyoado Community, Gboko LGA in Benue State.

The outreach was basically to provide financial assistance to students who meet the organization requirements for scholarships. In addition, the outreach was to raise awareness on the importance of Girl-Child education and encourage parents who witnessed the event to support girls' education.

The organization was able to reach three selected schools, which are Green Valley School, Kings Nursery and Primary School, and SAIA Nursery and Primary School. In the course of the outreach, the founder of the Premordia Charity Foundation sensitized the students and the parents that were present on the importance of Girl-Child education. He emphasized that it is good for girls to go to school because they would be supportive of both the growth of the society

and that of their husbands in future time. However, he encouraged academic excellence, as that is one of the major requirements for getting the scholarship. Furthermore, he encouraged the parents to work hard in order to be able to support their girls' education. In addition, he encouraged the teachers to be serious in disposing of their responsibilities to enable the students to become better in life, as education contributes largely to the betterment of a person.

After sensitizing, addressing the students and parents, the founder of the organization gave cheques to the Principal and Head teachers. This is to fulfill his promise of supporting Girl-Child education in those schools. The teachers and parents expressed their gratitude and happiness towards the kind gestures received from Premordia Charity Foundation. At the end, 31 students received scholarships. About 15 parents and community stakeholders were present.

The outreach turned out successful, even though there are challenges. Some of the challenges are a lack of funding, which has limited the number of beneficiaries. There was a delay in transporting the organization team to the schools as the community is a remote place. In view of these challenges, the organization seeks funding to support more students and establish a follow-up system to track the progress of the beneficiaries.

The outreach witnessed a huge success, reinforcing the importance of Girl-Child education. The NGO appreciates all her team members, partners, and volunteers who made this outreach a most impactful one.
